

PARENTS:

The information in this document contains an outline of stages for returning to normal school operations.

- Please note that situations may vary from school-to-school due to capacity limitations for both seating and for transportation.
- Some schools may have more availability for returning students than others. Therefore, the number of students returning for in-person learning is expected to be different for each school.
- School staff members will continuously evaluate the school situations so that as many students as possible are permitted to return to in-person learning.
- Your child's principal or other school personnel will contact you when there is space for your child.
- It is hoped that all students desiring to return will be able to do so. However, prohibitive circumstances may result in schools only being able to serve those currently on waitlists.

this next phase toward returning to normal school operations.

Stages in Returning to Normal Operations (Elementary, Middle, and High Schools)

- **Stage 1 – October 2020**

- Remediation for students experiencing academic difficulties
- Wednesdays and after school

Elementary School

- **Stage 2 – March 15, 2021 (As space is available)**
 - Waitlisted remote students in grades K-5 and at-risk fourth and fifth grade students return to in-person learning 4 days per week.
- **Stage 3 – March 29, 2021 (As space is available)**
 - Paper Packet Remote learners who are at-risk academically return to in-person learning 4 days per week.
- **Stage 4 –Date to be determined (As space is available)**
 - In-person hybrid (2 days per week) fourth and fifth grade students return to in-person learning 4 days per week.

Middle School

- **Stage 2 – March 29, 2021 (As space is available)**
 - In-person learners failing reading and/or math transition to 4 days per week
- **Stage 3 – April 19, 2021 (As space is available)**
 - Remote learners failing reading and/or math transition to in-person learning 4 days per week
- **Stage 4 – Date to be determined (As space is available)**
 - Additional remote learners will transition as space becomes available to in-person learning 4 days per week

High School

- **Stage 2 – March 29, 2021 (As space is available)**
 - In-person learners failing 4 courses at the end of the fourth marking period (prioritized by grade level) transition to 4 days per week
- **Stage 3 - April 19, 2021 (As space is available)**
 - Remote learners failing 4 courses at the end of the fourth marking period (prioritized by grade level) transition to 4 days per week
- **Stage 4 - Date to be determined (As space is available)**
 - In-person and remote learners failing 3 courses after April 19, 2021, will transition to 4 days per week

Pittsylvania Career and Technical Center

- **Stage 2 – February 22, 2021**
 - **All students are required to attend in-person 4 days per week**

Piedmont Governor's School for Mathematics, Science & Technology

- **Stage 2 – March 15, 2021 (As space is available)**
 - **In-person learners transition to 4 days per week**
